

# W. R. To Run One More Parcel Special Train With 2 Trips Between Palanpur And Cuttack



Ahmedabad, Western Rly has taken a unique initiative in providing transportation of essential commodities to various destinations of the country during the period of lockdown in wake of COVID 19. WR in its own way is well contributing through its services to the nation by running timetabled parcel special trains originating from various stations of WR. In continuation to this, one more parcel special train is scheduled to run between Palanpur of Gujarat and Cuttack of Odisha.

According to a press release issued by Shri Ravinder Bhakar - Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Rly, 2 trips of one parcel special will run between Palanpur and Cuttack. Train No 00961 Palanpur - Cuttack parcel special train will depart from Palanpur on 26th June, 2020 at 22.30 hrs & will reach Cuttack at 09.30 hrs on 28th

June, 2020. Similarly, Train No 00962 Cuttack - Palanpur parcel special train will leave Cuttack on 29th June, 2020 at 19.30 hrs & will reach Palanpur at 06.15 hrs on 1st July, 2020. The train will halt at Ahmedabad, Anand, Ratlam, Ujjain, Sant Hirdaram Nagar, Bina Jn, Katni Murwara, Bilaspur Jn, Jharsuguda Rd, Sambalpur City and Talcher Road stations in both directions. Shri Bhakar stated that since 23rd March to 21st June, 2020, commodities weighing more than 62 thousand tonnes have been transported by Western Rly through its 353 parcel special trains, which mainly included agricultural produce, medicines, fish, milk etc. The earnings generated through this transportation, has been approx Rs 20.01 crore. During this period, 46 milk special trains were run by Western Rly, with a load of more than 34 thousand tonnes and 100% utilization of the wagons, generating revenue of approx Rs 5.92 crore. Similarly, 301 Covid-19 special parcel trains with a load of more than 24 thousand tonnes were also run to transport essential commodities, for which the revenue earned was Rs 12.76 crore. In addition to this, 6 inter-

change points. 352 Millennium Parcel rakes of Parcel Vans / Railway Milk Tankers (RMTs) have been sent to different parts of the country to supply as per the demands of essential items such as milk powder, liquid milk and other general consumer goods. On 22nd June,

2020 one parcel special train left from Bandra Terminus to Ludhiana and one milk rake left from Palanpur to Hind Terminal. Shri Bhakar stated that the total loss of earnings over Western Railway on account of Corona Virus, has been over Rs 1415 crore, which includes Rs 203.83 crore for suburban section and Rs 1211.28 crore for non-suburban. In spite of this, resulting to cancellation of tickets till now, Western Railway has ensured to return refund amount of Rs. 356.98 crore. It's worth mentioning that in this refund amount, Mumbai division alone, has ensured refund of more than Rs 168.03 crore. Till now, 54.68 lakh passengers have cancelled their tickets over entire Western Railway & have received their refund amount accordingly.

# UP gov't orders thermal screening in all shelter homes



U.P., The Yogi Adityanath government in Uttar Pradesh has ordered thermal scanning of all staff and inmates of women shelter homes, orphanages and juvenile homes in the state. UP chief secretary Rajendra Kumar Tiwari, on Monday night, issued strict orders for implementation of all

precautions needed to check the spread of coronavirus. The move comes after 57 girls at a state-run shelter home in Kanpur had tested Corona positive. The chief secretary ordered that infrared thermometers should be made available for checking all people, including staff members, in women shelter homes, nari nicketans, orphanages and juvenile homes. He said that anyone having cold, cough or fever should not be allowed entry into these places. Letters for

strict compliance of these directives have been issued to the additional chief secretary and the principal secretaries of the Social Welfare and the Women and Child Development departments. The caretakers of these homes should reside in the facilities and ensure that all necessary precautions are being taken, the order said. The chief secretary further directed that in order to maintain cleanliness and hygiene, inmates should be provided soap and detergent powder. He said that those residing in these facilities should be provided masks and handkerchiefs to cover their faces. Social distancing norms should be strictly followed. The number of visitors of the inmates should be kept at the minimum and they should be properly screened if meeting was absolutely necessary. UP chief secretary Rajendra Kumar Tiwari, on Monday night, issued strict orders for implementation of all precautions needed to check the spread of coronavirus.

The recovery rate of patients of the coronavirus disease (Covid-19) in Uttar Pradesh, India's most populous state, is higher than most of the states hit by the pandemic and it has seen a steady decrease in the number of active cases.

Hindustan, HT's sister publication, cited Amit Mohan Prasad—UP's additional chief secretary of the medical and health department—as saying that more than 11,000 Covid-19 patients have been cured so far taking the recovery rate to 63.31%. Follow latest updates on coronavirus here There were 11,601 patients, out of 17,731, who have been discharged in the state until June 21. Now there are 6,186

active cases in the northern state, according to data. The rate of the active cases is also improving at a rapid rate in UP as patients are getting discharged from hospitals. At present, only 36.40% of active cases are in the state. India's Covid-19 death toll goes beyond 14,000, infection tally over 4.40 lakh On June 21, 596 people were found infected with Sars-Cov-2, the virus which causes the coronavirus disease and 626 patients were discharged. Prasad also said that 569 people have died in the state so far. Prasad said that 150,79 samples were tested in the state on Sunday and 574,340 samples have been tested in the state. He also said that rapid antigen tests will also be started in the state soon. In the first phase, this investigation will be started in Lucknow, Prayagraj, Varanasi, Gorakhpur and Kanpur Nagar. After this, the test will be conducted in western Uttar Pradesh, especially in the districts under the National Capital Region (NCR), he said.

## WTC Gift City gears up to accelerate the state's economy

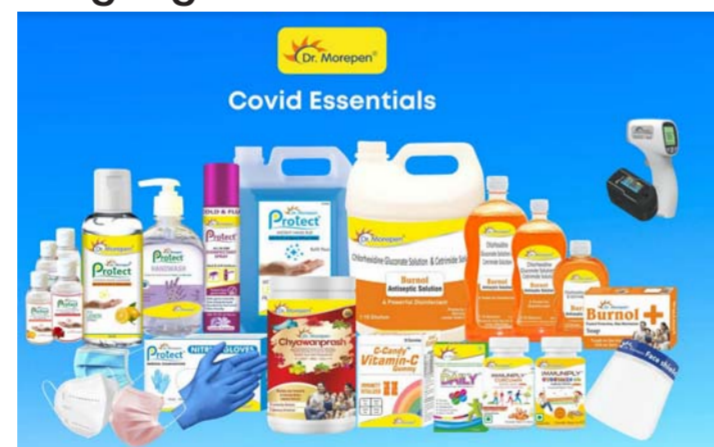

## Morepen Labs clocks double digit growth in FY 2019-20



Ahmedabad, Morepen Laboratories Ltd. has reported a 16.43 per cent rise in its Net Profit (Consolidated) at Rs. 33.58 crore. Net Consolidated Revenue during the year rose by 11.7 per cent at Rs. 862.55 crore. The company's net profit was Rs. 28.84 crore on a net revenue of Rs. 772.21 crore in the previous fiscal. The EBIDTA (Consolidated) for FY 2019-20 rose by 9.6 per cent at Rs. 78 crore and the Cash Profit (Consolidated) by 10 per cent at Rs. 76.02 crore. Consolidated Profit before Tax (PBT) recorded extraordinary growth by 34 per cent at Rs. 39.11 crore, up from Rs. 29.18 crore in the previous fiscal. Domestic Sales Revenue in FY 2019-20 was up by 11.75 per cent at Rs. 496.36 crore and Export Sales Revenue up by 10 per cent at Rs. 343.24 crore. In the domestic market, best performance came from Atorvastatin with 94 per cent growth in FY 2019-20. In the exports market, Rosuvastatin registered a good growth of 30 per cent and Loratadine 18 per cent in FY 2019-20. API

Sales Revenue during the year grew by 14.74 per cent at Rs. 473.95 crore with an impressive growth of 28 percent in Domestic and 10 percent in Exports. Home Diagnostics Sales Revenue grew by 20.46 per cent at Rs. 168.35 crore with Blood Glucose Monitors' sales up by 29 percent and Nebulisers' by 44 percent. OTC Sales Revenue grew by 18.84 per cent at Rs. 64.63 crore with Grooming Business showing extraordinary growth of 58 per cent. Branded Formulation Sales Revenue grew by 18.62 per cent at Rs. 40.64 crore. Generic Formulation was down by 18.49 percent at Rs. 96.93 crore in FY 2019-20. The bulk drugs (API) segment contributed around 56 per cent to the company's total sales turnover in FY19-20. Within the API segment, Finished APIs have registered a growth of 14 per cent at Rs. 414.39 Crores, Intermediates' grew by 24 per cent at Rs. 31.50 Crores whereas NewMolecules' have added Rs. 28.06 Crores to the company's top line.
